Call to order - Meeting called to order at 6:37 pm by President Maggie Piotter.

Treasurer's Report - Connie Nelson

- PTO Checking balance is \$13,000.14, PTO Checking 2 is \$419.28 (giving account) PTO Savings \$10,022.74.
- Connie is having difficulty pulling a monthly statement from Flagstar. There have also been
 checks deposited into a wrong account. We are looking at switching banks depending on check
 cost and fees. Motion to switch banks made by Teresa Caron, 2nd by Aggie Cottrell. All in favor.

School News - Kelly Jensenius

- Karen Fitz Henry decided to retire this summer. Ben Critz moved to 5th grade leaving a 2nd grade position open. 11 people were interviewed for the 2nd grade position and Jamie Hall was hired. She comes from KPS with about 10 years of experience.
- Ashley Vance due soon and will have a long-term sub for the fall. Katie Hicks is now on long term leave due to pregnancy issues. She will stay home for the year. Chris Stacy offered a 1-year Kindergarten position to replace Katie.
- Ally Leverett had a baby this summer. Amelia Simpson from 12th street will be long term sub.
 She will be here until after Thanksgiving break.
- Mike Cram is the new art teacher. Summer Walker is the new special education instructor.
- Megan Glefke left to work at KRESA Head start program. Megan Faraci was hired for Young 5's.
- There is a new closed Facebook page to let parents know what's going on in the classrooms. This will allow more communication and open discussions between parents and students.
- There was some painting done throughout the building including the cafeteria.
- Miranda Day is teaching 5th grade at Angling Road.
- Spruce Up day is this Friday Aug 25. There will be mulch delivered.
- Monday Aug 28 there will be a new student meet and greet. There will also be a meet and greet for Kindergarten students. Captains Crew students will be giving students tours of the school.
- We are training a new protocol for school safety called ALICE. Effie, Kelly and Pat Baltmanis went to training and are working with Portage Police to learn how to execute a school lock down. The whole staff will be trained on the protocol and a meeting will be held for parents.

New Business

By-laws & Waivers – All information is in the Board Binder and must sign a waiver acknowledging receipt of the bylaws. All board members are receiving a bag with the PTO binders including updated contact information and calendar.

Volunteer Background check – Everyone needs to fill out a volunteer background check form. This needs to be completed every year.

Team Contract -Teaming up for a great year!

- Chairperson Guidelines are in the PTO binder. Sarah Overholt, Vice President, will be the liaison for all events. Sarah is also in charge of communications. She can help with advertising for your events. 3rd Friday of the month is the deadline for events in the following month's newsletter. Send Sarah a quick paragraph to put into the newsletter about your event.
- Staff meetings are the 2nd Tuesday of the month. Send email to Pat or Sharon if you want information sent out to teachers. It's usually best to announce no more than 3 weeks before the event. Can use Facebook, email, PTO newsletter, teachers' newsletters, handouts, Weebly, bulletin boards.
- Event timelines
 - o 2 months out: touch base
 - o 1 month out: check in for any support needed
 - Meeting before event: give a quick status update and plan especially if you can't make it to the meeting
 - o Meeting after event: Event summary and financials due 7 days after event
 - Meeting policy- Should miss no more than 6 meetings for the year

PTO Calendar – need to finalize dates by next mtg. on Sept. 12th, before Open House Event Assignments

- Everyone has been assigned their events. All the event files and summaries are available. They will be in the PTO file cabinet or on Google Drive.
- Be aware of your event budget. Email Connie with any questions about what was spent last year or what items were bought.
 - o If you go over, each event is allowed 10% grace per by laws, just notify us with the reasons why so we can plan/adjust for future years.

Budget Preview

- Warm Kids didn't spend any money out of the budget. We are changing this to a line item to cover any student needs.
- Movie Nights dropping to \$200.
- Bus Driver breakfast taken out of the budget and adding to the Teacher Appreciation Event.
- Lake Center Legends is a break even. Stephanie decreased the quantity ordered so there aren't as many extra. Pictures are available at Open House. They will be taken September 9. Teachers are being asked to encourage students to wear LCE spirit wear on the day of pictures.
- Mileage Club dropped to \$50.
- Money for Staff Requests is going into checking 2. Right now, there's around \$3000-\$4000
 available to start the year. Any surplus from Turtle Trot will be added to the giving account after
 the event.
- Teacher reimbursements \$150/full time, \$75/part time
- Ice Cream Social dropped from \$600-\$350.

Treasury – checks will be written at meetings.

• If you have a large charge, you can submit between meetings. Ask larger companies to send an invoice so you don't have to cover.

Volunteers – look into Senior Center, high school students

Konstella – This allows Sarah and Maggie to be admins of all of the PTO events. It has a community board that is available for co-chairs to discuss the event instead of emailing back and forth. Sarah has added everyone to their respective events. She has also added the documents from Google drive in each event. This will hopefully give parents easier access to PTO signups and a better idea of what is going on.
