New Business

Budget Proposal – Proposed spending is within \$1 of proposed income. Be aware of your event budget. There are areas that we can shift spending if Turtle Trot income isn't as expected.

Teacher Requests – Mrs. Vaughn is here to share about a new program for Kindergarten and Young 5's. Last April Mrs. Jensenius sent the kindergarten teachers to the Zones of Regulation conference in Chicago. This training focuses on helping students understand and deal with emotions/feelings and also helping them recognize other people's emotions. They are now trying to incorporate their training into their classrooms and helping to teach student about common emotions they are experiencing. Teachers will ask students how they are feeling and why they are feeling like that. The teachers are creating tubs to help students deal with their emotions. Each tub contains sensory objects and calming techniques to help students get out of their "zone". They are requesting funds to purchase books for their own classrooms about feelings and how to deal with them. They are also requesting funds to buy sensory objects for each of the zones.

Proposal: Literature and sensory tools to help us integrate the Zones of Regulation curriculum into our classrooms to help develop students' ability to self-regulate their emotions

- 5 \$300 per teacher = book library and CDs
- 5-\$100 per teacher = sensory tools for calming spaces in classrooms
